**PUBLIC APPEARANCES:**

A. Christmas Lighting Contest Award Presentation.

Mayor Rivera expressed the Council's appreciation of the many bright lights and the beautiful decoration on each house and how it makes the Town of Thatcher look so nice. It announced the Grand Prize to be Luke Hoopes, First Prize David Ramirez, Second Prize Carlos Montano, Third Prize Chad Rolfe and the Honorable Mentions are Raul Alaniz, Joe Sedgeman, Darla Doge, Juanita Ornelas, Dawn Wood. Mayor Rivera said again we appreciation what you do.

B. Chamber of Commerce – Tom Claridge

Tom Claridge stood and said he was here to report on what the Chamber is doing. We have an interim board in place at this time. We are trying to decide what and where we should go. We have cut budget 60%, actively search for members and talked to each even ask if they would like to serve on board. We should have a new Board by late March and up and rolling by April. We have 300 members and not all active. After looking at the money we have and the amount going out we are needing around 10,000.00, anything Thatcher can help us with would be appreciate. A lot of changes need to be made with advertising, web page, face book and brochure. Terry said I believe we have in our budget the amount of 6500.00 set aside for the Chamber. We need a letter of request.

C. Boys and Girls Club Funding Request – Ed Ragland

Ed Ragland stood and thanked Council for helping the Boys and Girls Club. We have a new director Shelly DeLeon. We are well and growing. We are growing went from 72 to 90

students. We feel we are addressing an important issue in the Gila Valley that being graduating the kids through high school. We have built our reserves to about two months. We are looking at building more revenue I talked with Graham County Drew John about taking from their Community Foundation money and ear marking it for us. We would like to invite you to join in with us and over a period of say three years commit to give us 1500.00 a year. Mayor Rivera asked if they had looked at doing in kind help from the different entities like maintenance on vehicles. Mayor Rivera suggested a meeting with all three entities so you will know what each can help with. Terry said if the Council chooses to donate we can go through the Community Foundation and ear mark those funds to Boys and Girls Club. Ed Ragland said if you have any other ideas please let me know. I appreciate the support the Town of Thatcher gives us.

- A. **ORDINANCE NO. 178-2015:** AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF THATCHER, ARIZONA AMENDING TITLE IX, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF THATCHER, ADDING CHAPTER 91: PROVIDING A LOCATION FOR AN UNLAWFUL MINOR PARTY/GATHERING, AKA THE SOCIAL HOST ORDINANCE

Terry said this is an Ordinance that Chief Brugman and Chief Woods have been working on for the valley. We have had our own police attorney look it and is ok with it but not sure we needed it we have statues that already take care of it. Chief Woods said it gives law enforce another tool to stop underage drinking. What it does is makes and adult that is hosting a party and there is underage drinking the adult is responsible and will receive the ticket. This makes it a civil violation so will not show on criminal record. I believe Pima and Safford have already passed this. Mayor Rivera asked if Chief Woods was in support and the answer was yes. Kathy Grimes director of the Graham County Substance Abuse Coalition provide information on the effects of underage drinking and thanked Council for taking into consideration the Social Host Ordinance.

Councilman Rapier made motion to approve Ordinance No. 178-2015. Councilman Innes seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Motion passed

- B. **RESOLUTION NO. 634-2015:** A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF THATCHER, GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE

AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING SPPA WCF2 PROJECT AMONG SOUTHWEST PUBLIC POWER AGENCY, INC., THE TOWN OF THATCHER, AND THE CITY OF SAFFORD AUTHORIZING ITS EXECUTION AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN COUNCIL TO TAKE SUCH ADDITIONAL ACTIONS AS ARE NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROJECT AND THE INVESTMENT OF FUNDS.

Terry said we are part of the SPPA Group along with other agency own 25% of the Mesquite Power Plant. City of Safford and us are the only municipalities in the group. The agreement requires us to put up a letter of credit or put in the funds. We put in the money and since municipalities have restriction on how and what we can invest in this agreement needs to be in place. The other entities want to be able to invest for a longer period of time taking a higher risk and earning a higher interest rate but we can only invest for 5 years. They want to go longer and take a higher risk earning a higher interest rate. This allows SPPA to set up two funds.

Councilman Griffin made motion to approve the Resolution No. 634-2015. Vice Mayor Allen seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous, Motion passed

C. Health Insurance renewal.

Terry said the health insurance renews at first of year. By making the changes we did this last year we saved 168,000.00. We also increased coverage by adding a prescription plan. The complaints we have from employee was customer service but we are changing to a TPA ( third party administrator) which means employees will only have to call one person instead of two or three. The insurance plan itself will stay the same. Terry said staff would recommend staying the same with exception of new TPA.

Councilman Innes made motion to renew the Health Insurance Plan. Councilman Larson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous motion passed

D. Water Conservation Ordinance review.

Terry said this is not an action item. Heath passed on the comment the Council had from last meeting. They have incorporated the changes and redid the master plant list. They feel it is really close to what needs to be passed. Once they think it is what they want the City of Safford will put it in an Ordinance and then will be passed to you. Council agreed on the changes.

E. Golf Course Discussion.

Terry said he had a meeting with Horatio, Heath and Dustin about the poor condition of the Golf Course after they took it back. In my opinion I think the valley needs the golf course. The citizens, snow birds, mine, hospital all use it. I think we could look at helping. We can waive the garbage and sewer fees, in kind help and the sales tax. They are asking right now for money to get through the year of 20,000.00. Mayor Rivera said I think is so good for the ecomic develop snow birds will come back if we have a good course it will be good for everyone. Terry said there are some big dollar things that need to be replaced, sprinkler system, golf carts the club house. Councilman Innes said his father while on the Council tried to get Safford to let us be part of a board so we can have some say. It sounds like they are willing to do that now. I think we could take that opportunity. Vice Mayor Allen ask does this provide ownership. Terry said at this point everything is on the table whatever works the best is what they are looking at. Councilman Griffin asked if we had the 20,000

available. Terry said there is 5 thousand that I know is available and give more later. Alma Flores said she is manager over the Golf Course project. Alma said we do want to hear your idea and as getting a board together would be good. Some of the equipment is not worth fixing anymore. Councilman Rapier asked if we authorized the 5 thousand is there something that needs the most help. Alma said the golf carts generate revenue we have 30 and only 12 are running so to get those bringing in revenue would be good. Mayor Rivera said with us being able to help with decision making this will be a good thing.

Councilman Rapier made the motion to approve up to \$5000 to be used on the golf carts. Vice Mayor Allen seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous Motion passed

#### **INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:**

##### A. Town Manager's Report:

Terry said as of July 1, 2015 our population is now 5125. We are working on College Ave. we have about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of curbs and sidewalk should be finished before kids are back to school. The foundation on concession building is poured. Santa in Park went well but it was cold so when Santa left everyone self did. We are moving electrical poles on College Ave. Councilman Innes said on 1<sup>st</sup> we put all that new asphalt right up to the curb and left a pole is that going to be moved. Answer was yes. Councilman Rapier asked with the paving going all the way to curb the jet out to the canal seems a lot more dangerous. Terry said there are a lot of issues connected with that bridge so it will not be done soon. We can put more reflectors or bigger sign will work on that.

##### A. Fire Department Report.

Chief Payne said there is going to be another Fire Fighter class 1 & 2 which the fire department is going to sponsor. We have 6 firemen that will attend. They are condensing it from one year to three months still giving them the 240 hours of class. The class will start January 18<sup>th</sup>. We went out to the new home being built that is 9000 sq ft. and has no city water only ponds to see what we would need to do in case of fire. As you know there is something in the works for the Central water system so we tested some hydrants and gave that information to the College, Graham Co. Utilities, and City of Safford. We had 70 call outs this year.

##### B. Police Department Report.

Chief Woods we are participating in the W Steven Martin toy drive this year. Officer West went today and picked up enough toys for five or six families. We will have officers deliver them on Christmas Eve. We will be participating in the DUI Task Force during the holiday season. Our Detectives worked with the Task Force which had 13 local warrants. Chief Brugman from City of Safford applied for grant through Homeland Security for lap top computer for every officer in the valley and we have received one so far which is about 5 thousand dollars so we appreciate that.

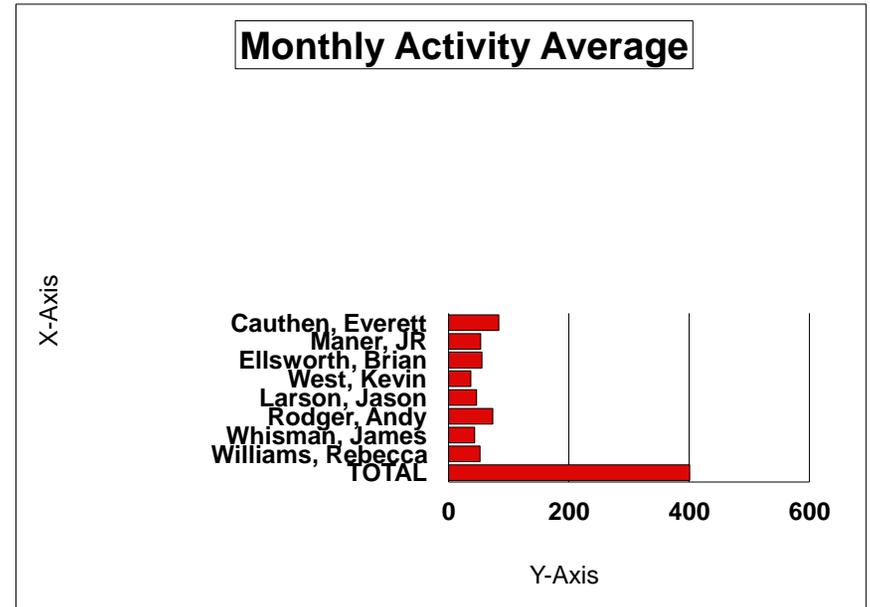
