Welcome and Call Meeting to Order by Mayor Rivera at 6:32. He stated that we do have a quorum. On behalf of this council I would ask our Heavenly Father to watch over those in the armed forces, especially those in harms way, our first responders, police and fire, EMT's, border patrol, custom agents, Marshalls, and everyone who protects us.

He mentioned that they are rolling out new by-laws, voting on new members, and there will be a lot of information given. Some of the highlights are that we have a programmer working on a voice app for our members, like asking Alexa and Siri what different business' hours, our new website, and our new Gila Valley App.

A. Town of Thatcher Employee Handbook Update

Mr. Brown explained that we did not have the revisions back from the Employer's Council for the handbook but will get it out to Council as soon as we get it for review.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

A. Town Manager's Report

Mr. Brown stated that we have relocated all the power at the recreational complex. We also got the water service installed. We still have a ways to go but it is starting to take shape. We have about another month to go on the earth work. Church Street is going well, but I'll let Mr. Palmer tell you about that. Mr. Palmer mentioned that Hatch is the general contractor and Lusk is the one that is the concrete sub. It goes a lot quicker when they can use the curbing machine. They are entirely done with the first block up to 1st Avenue and Hatch will come in within the next two weeks and start getting the road ready and the base. They will start in two weeks with the curbing machine on the north side between 1st& 3^{rd} Avenues now that we have sidewalk that is usable, so we can push pedestrians to the south. I am optimistic that we will still hit our February deadline. Councilwoman Smith asked if the asphalt will go all the way to the sidewalk and Mr. Palmer stated that it will be to the curb. Vice Mayor Allen asked what the plan is for working around the College. Are they going to do that during Christmas when everyone is gone? Mr. Palmer replied that they think they might get to that before the break. Mayor Rivera said we would like to thank our residents for being so patient.

We have a General Plan Meeting Thursday and we will also have a meeting to go

over the Highway Beautification Plan. The broadband grant that Councilwoman Smith brought up at the last meeting is being worked on. I don't know exactly what our role will be, but they may have an idea of how to help us with the cause. We also had a request from Hughes Network Systems and they want a letter from us to help support them. EAC is going to go ahead and get the EAC theme street signs ordered and then we will help get those installed.

The last thing I have is that the Mayor and I attended a Mayor/Manager meeting with Pima, Safford, and the County. We discussed the water situation and the three Mayors signed a letter to the Tribal Council encouraging them to seek alternative solutions and meet with us. Mr. Skeet talked about the Veteran's Day event that the Lion's Club is doing. We have six different flags with the donation that council approved that we will have there. What we discussed the most was sales tax sharing which the Mayor of Pima brought up. They are becoming more and more a bedroom community, so they are interested in some type of sales tax sharing. They really want 2% of Walmart, but we discussed lots of different ideas. One idea would be if any new businesses come in we share a percentage of that. One idea would be a flat line sales tax number, and then if the next year our sales tax increases then we take a percentage of that and share it with Pima. I don't know if this is going anywhere, but I assume at some point you as a council will be hearing from their council. Mayor Rivera stated that we left it up to the Manger's to discuss some options.

B. Fire Department Report

Chief Payne mentioned that we just had our open house a few weeks ago and it was the most people that we have ever had. It is good to give people some education on what we do and to help recruit. We were given a house down in Central that we are going to be doing some training on. Councilwoman Howard asked if you have ever set up a booth at any events to try to recruit fireman. Chief Payne stated that we do at the Dump the Drugs event at Home Depot. Mayor Rivera stated please on behalf of this council thank our fire fighters.

C. Police Department Report

Chief Woods stated that I did want to let you know that we received our new police car from the GOHS grant. If you notice, it is black, but that is all that we could find with our time frame. We also are signing all the grant paperwork for the upcoming year. With Halloween coming up we will be bringing out the light towers at Quail Ridge. Search and Rescue usually helps with that, but we aren't sure what will happen yet. Other than that we had a few bad traffic accidents last month with one knocking out power and a bad motorcycle accident as well. Mayor Rivera asked if we have heard anything on a school resource officer yet. Chief Woods mentioned that we should be hearing something soon, but there were a lot more applicants then they had thought. Vice Mayor Allen asked if we could get some more solar powered flashing lights on 1st Street. Councilman Bryce

stated that they could be brighter. Vice Mayor Allen also mentioned that we may need some on Church Street as well. Mayor Rivera stated thank you and please thank our officers.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (Gila River Linear Park and Trail)

This Memorandum of Understanding ("**MOU**"), dated as of ______ of November, 2019 (the "**Effective Date**"), by and between the CITY OF SAFFORD, ARIZONA (the "**City**"), the TOWN OF THATCHER, ARIZONA (the "**Town**"), the COUNTY OF GRAHAM, ARIZONA (the "**County**"), the GILA WATERSHED PARTNERSHIP OF ARIZONA, an Arizona non-profit corporation ("**GWP**"), THE TRUST FOR PUBLIC LAND, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation authorized to do business in Arizona as TPL-Arizona, Inc. ("**TPL**"), and the following private individuals and entities that own land in Graham County:

RIVER VIEW PROPERTIES LLC, an Arizona limited liability company ("**River View Properties**"), FREEPORT MCMORAN SAFFORD INC., a Delaware corporation ("**FMI**"), LANGLEY MT. GRAHAM MALL LLC, an Arizona limited liability company ("**Langley**"), TED PRINA, BRUCE ROSS, RONALD HOWARD, and IVAN SMITH (these private individuals and entities are collectively known as the "**Private Landowners**"),

(all parties named above are collectively known as the "**Parties**") for the purpose of establishing and achieving various goals and objectives relating to the establishment and operation of a linear park and trail along the Gila River in portions of the County (the "**Gila River Trail**") as described herein. For purposes of this MOU, a linear park is defined as an elongated park in an urban or suburban setting that typically follows a natural feature such as a river, lakefront or abandoned rail bed; as contrasted to limiting the project scope to a trail, the use of the term 'linear park' in this particular project is for the potential that the project may also include other recreation or natural features and amenities desired by the community such as riparian restoration areas (including the removal of salt cedar), small ponds or wetlands, interpretative signage, picnic tables and ramadas (and as such uses may be allowed by the Private Landowners).

WHEREAS, the City, Town and County desire to see a Gila River linear park and trail created in order to provide recreational benefits for their residents and visitors; to create opportunities for equestrian, hiking, and biking trails, riparian restoration and wildlife habitat; to offer benefits for eco-tourism and regional economic development; and to create beneficial public uses for the 100-year floodplain of the river, which is generally unsuitable for other development. Additionally, such a project furthers a number of objectives and goals described in the City's General Plan (as approved in December, 2016); and

WHEREAS, the City owns property of 45 acres, more or less, at 8th Avenue and the Gila River that is described in its General Plan as the site of a future sports complex and recreational area and further described as tax parcel 102-12-002 (the "**City Parcel**"); and

WHEREAS, the Private Landowners own parcels along the Gila River described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto that may be part of the Gila River Trail; and

WHEREAS, TPL is a nonprofit organization with a mission "to create parks and protect land for people, ensuring healthy, livable communities for generations to come" and desires to assist the Parties in the creation of a Gila River Trail; and

WHEREAS, GWP has expertise in restoration of the Gila River in the planned project area including operation of a native plant nursery in Safford.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. <u>OBJECTIVES</u>. The purpose of this MOU is to provide the framework for the creation of a Gila River Trail for an initial stretch of approximately three to four miles along the south side of the Gila River in the floodplain and including the following deliverables: (a) a conceptual master plan for the design of a Gila River Trail that incorporates input from the City, Town, County, public and other key stakeholders and (b) trail easements across public and private lands. These deliverables are the first phase of, and serve as the foundation for, an overall project leading to the establishment of a Gila River Trail.
- 2. <u>ROLES OF THE PARTIES</u>. The Parties plan on the following roles to meet the objectives stated herein:
 - a. TPL would seek to provide the following services (provided sufficient public and/or private funding can be secured to underwrite TPL's costs of such services and TPL obtains management approval to undertake such work):
 - Contract with a landscape architect firm with expertise in parks and trails design (the "Architect") to develop a conceptual Master Plan for the Gila River Trail, and
 - Conduct the real estate work that, in the opinion of TPL, is appropriate to establish trail easements across private lands (e.g. surveys, title work, other due diligence) from the Private Landowners, and seek to negotiate trail easements with the owners.
 - b. City, Town and County intend to carry out the following:
 - Advise TPL and the Architect on the linear park and trail master plan design including recreational and design elements desired by City and County, provide expertise on matters such as floodplain management issues and future development plans, and potential for connectivity with existing recreational trails; and
 - Determine the best entity (City or Town or County) to hold each of the planned trail easements comprising the Gila River Trail, and assist TPL in reaching agreement on terms for such easements that are agreeable to the Private Landowners;
 - Make existing GIS data available to TPL and Architect that will help in the project design, provide meeting rooms for stakeholder and other project meetings, provide general notifications to the public for planned public meeting (described in Exhibit C);
 - Provide TPL and Architect with available transportation improvement plans within the project area;
 - Request review and decisions by City Council, Town Council, and County Board of Supervisors of the master plan and trail easements as appropriate; and

- City will make the City Parcel available for the Gila River Trail, including trailhead and parking location, subject to City's approval of specifics of the master plan.
- c. GWP will carry out the following:
 - Assist TPL in securing private funding for the services described above, and also consider requests that may be made by TPL to City or Town or County for professional service fees to fund such services; and
 - Organize and coordinate public meetings to gain feedback on desired features of the park, and
 - Provide advice and expertise to TPL and the Architect for incorporation of riparian restoration, demonstration sites, floodplain management, and interpretative signage into the master plan in order to enhance the final design and educate the public about the importance of the river.
 - Assist the City, Town and County in seeking funding for implementation of the master plan.
- d. The Private Landowners individually agree in concept to provide the use of land for trail easements along the floodplain of their properties for siting of the Gila River Trail and agree to enter into a perpetual trail easement with City or Town or County for such linear park and trail, subject to the following conditions:
 - Each of the Private Landowners has the right to review and approve the specific route of the trail and to review the master plan, and will also have the opportunity to provide input on such matters to TPL, the Architect, GWP, City, Town and County.
 - Each of the Private Landowners must be satisfied with the terms of the trail easement across their property.

Additionally the Private Landowners grant TPL, the Architect and GWP and their employees, agents and contractors permission to enter upon their respective properties for the purposes of developing a Master Plan and other investigations related to the properties in the proposed Gila River Trail area.

3. ADDITIONAL UNDERSTANDINGS OF THE PARTIES

- a. This MOU is not intended to and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility. No liability will arise or be assumed among the Parties as a result of this MOU.
- b. This MOU shall in no way obligate any Party to any financial commitments except those specifically agreed to in this MOU.

- c. No legal partnership or agency is established by this MOU. No party is authorized or empowered to act as an agent, employee or representative of any other.
- d. This MOU may be amended or modified at any time in writing by mutual consent of the parties.
- e. This MOU will be effective upon the signature of the Parties.
- f. Any Party may terminate its participation in this MOU by providing written notice to the others.
- 4. <u>REPRESENTATIVES</u>. Each party shall appoint an authorized representative (or representatives) for such party. The initial representatives for the Parties are identified with contact information in Exhibit D.



Introduction:

The Gila Watershed Partnership (GWP) is a 501(c)3 non-profit conservation organization based in Safford, an agriculture and mining community in southeast Arizona. The GWP's mission is to engage the community and partners in improving the water quality and ecosystem condition of the Upper Gila Watershed through mitigation, restoration, education and economic opportunity. GWP's goals are to:

- Conserve natural resources
- Increase river-based recreational opportunities for all users
- Teach the importance of water resources
- Enrich the local economy
- Improve water quality and availability
- Plan and act to avoid and minimize damage from major storms, floods, fire, and other natural disasters.

Throughout our 26 years in existence, the GWP has worked with over 40 local, regional, and national partners to accomplish 35 watershed improvement projects in the Gila Valley. Through these projects we seek not only to improve the quality of the environment within the Upper Gila Watershed, but also to provide economic and social benefits to the people living within the watershed. The GWP has been and continues to be an organization that facilitates dialogue, collaboration, and action between groups that typically may not work together.

The Trust for Public Land (TPC) is a non-profit that works to protect the places people care about and to create close-to-home parks, particularly in and near cities, where 80 percent of Americans live. TPC's goal is to ensure that every child has easy access to a safe place to play in nature. TPC also works to conserve working farms, ranches, and forests; lands of historical and cultural importance; rivers, streams, coasts, and watersheds; and other special places where people can experience nature close at hand.

McGann & Associates is a Tucson, Arizona based professional landscape architectural firm with experience related to the planning of river parks and greenways in Arizona. The firm has prepared master plans for linear parks similar to that proposed along the Gila and master plans for other natural resource areas.

The Trust for Public Land, the Gila Watershed Partnership, the City of Safford, Graham County, and other interested stakeholders have agreed to collaborate on the preparation of a master plan for a (+/-) 3 mile long river park along the south bank of the Gila River in Safford, Arizona. McGann & Associates has agreed to assist with the provision of professional planning and design services.

TPL intends to contract with McGann & Associates Inc. (the Consultant) for the preparation of the subject master plan. The information and services to be provided by the GWP, TPL, and McGann & Associates shall be as identified herein.

Project Background and Goals:

The Gila River Linear Park and Trail (the Park and Trail) was conceived as a way to connect the Gila Valley communities to the river. The Gila Valley encompasses the City of Safford, the towns of Thatcher, Pima, and Solomon, the San Carlos Apache Reservation, and numerous unincorporated communities. Despite the proximity of these communities to the Gila River, many of the residents do not use the river for recreation or other benefits, and issues like illegal garbage dumping and vandalism are common. The Gila Watershed Partnership has worked with the City of Safford and Graham County on a number of projects to clean garbage from the river, educate residents about water quality and conservation, and promote positive use of the river for recreation. The GWP believes, however, that limited river access prevents residents from developing a sense of ownership and therefore a sense of stewardship of the river resources. Until there is a large-scale change in how the community values the river, these issues will persist.

One of the challenges in connecting people to the river is the degraded plant community within the Upper Gila floodplain. Tamarisk, also called Salt Cedar (*Tamarisk chinensis*), is an invasive tree that grows densely along many river systems in the west and makes up approximately 90% of the area along the Upper Gila River. Its density prevents people from entering the floodplain and enjoying the river. It also negatively impacts plant and animal biodiversity by crowding and shading out other plants, creating a near-monoculture which degrades the recreational experience. Other negative impacts include bank impoundment and river channelization due to the thick root structures that prevent natural scouring and meandering of desert rivers, and a subsequent decrease in water quality.

Tamarisk negatively impacts the local culture as well. It is a leading cause of the degradation of traditional San Carlos Apache ceremonial sites. Coyote willow (*Salix exigua*) is a small, pliable tree that grows on river banks and is used by the San Carlos Apache to construct temporary lodges within which religious ceremonies are conducted. Due to the density and extent of tamarisk, there are very few sites along the Gila River that still support Coyote willow, and members of the Apache Tribe have begun working with the Gila Watershed Partnership to locate places where they can harvest cuttings from this tree for propagation and re-planting as needed to restore ceremonial sites.

The Gila Watershed Partnership, along with the Trust for Public Land, Graham County, the City of Safford, and private land owners, envision a 3+ mile linear park and trail along the south side of the Gila River, immediately north of the Town of Thatcher and the City of Safford. The park would provide **recreational benefits** by providing access to the river in a sustainable manner, **biodiversity benefits** by removing tamarisk and restoring native habitat, **economic benefits** by creating a destination for tourists leading to regional economic development, **educational benefits** through interpretive and demonstration opportunities, **floodplain benefits** that create community uses for land that is unsuitable for other development, and **cultural benefits** by creating a site where Coyote willow can thrive and cuttings can be harvested for ceremonial purposes and restoration.

Scope of Work:

The planning, design, engineering, and construction of the proposed linear park will be implemented in several phases. The scope of work outlined below is for the initial master planning phase.

Task 1: Project Definition / Visioning

The Consultant shall meet with representatives of the GWP, TPL, the City of Safford, and Graham County as required to identify the approximate limits of the proposed linear park and to identify the potential recreational and environmental restoration features of the proposed linear park. As part of this task:

The Consultant will:

- Participate in and help coordinate a one-day workshop (in Safford) and site tour
- Prepare and distribute summary notes related to the visioning workshop

<u>The GWP will</u>:

- Identify and invite stakeholders to the workshop
- Arrange for meeting room
- Coordinate the site tour

The TPL will:

- Participate in the workshop in person or by teleconference
- Provide input related to TPL's experience on similar projects

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

- General site / area map for discussion at workshop based on best-available information
- Summary notes from the visioning workshop

Task 2: Data Collection and Mapping

Working in concert with the GWP and TPL, the Consultant shall prepare a base map for the project area that indicates the underlying land ownership, the existing roadway / bridge improvements, and the limits of the floodplain associated with the Gila River. Information shall also be collected on planned transportation improvements and proposed private development. The mapped information shall be from available City of Safford, Graham County, or other similar sources and shall be in .shp or .dwg file format. The GWP shall coordinate and provide assistance working with the City and the County as required to collect the necessary data files.

In addition to the information noted above, the Consultant shall prepare a map layer that illustrates the vegetative communities along the subject reach of the Gila River. The mapping of the vegetative communities will be prepared by the GWP and / or others under the direction of the GWP.

The Consultant will:

- Collect, review, and integrate the data files required for base mapping
- Provide the GWP a list of specific data files to be requested from local jurisdictions / agencies
- Prepare base maps for master plan development

The GWP will:

- Conduct or coordinate surveys of the vegetative communities within the project area
- Coordinate all requests for data files from the City of Safford and Graham County

<u>The TPL will</u>:

• Provide data files for the subject area as may have been collected by TPL

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

• A base map for the project area with information on land ownership, existing rights-of-way, existing roadways, floodplain limits, planned municipal improvements, and vegetative communities. The base map to be in .shp file format and shall be suitable for master planning purposes

Task 3: Key Stakeholder Input

The Consultant shall conduct two workshops / meetings to solicit stakeholder input. These meeting will be held at separate times on the same day in Safford. The first meeting shall be with City, County, other public agencies, and impacted land owners. The second meeting shall be with user group representatives and interested individuals. At these meetings a summary of existing conditions will be presented and comments and recommendations for linear park development will be requested.

The Consultant will:

• Prepare an information packet related to existing conditions for distribution and discussion at the stakeholder workshops

The GWP will:

- Identify stakeholders to be invited to the workshops
- Send invitations to the various stakeholders
- Coordinate with the City and/or County and secure a meeting room for the workshops

The TPL will:

• Participate in the workshops as-appropriate

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

- An information packet for distribution to meeting participants
- Exhibits to be presented at the workshops
- A brief written summary of input provided by stakeholders

Task 4: Conceptual Design

Based on input received from stakeholders, the Consultant shall prepare a conceptual development plan for the proposed linear park. The conceptual plan will illustrate and/or note the scope and character of the proposed recreational and environmental restoration improvements.

The Consultant will:

• Prepare a conceptual design for the project corridor including a graphic presentation of the proposed improvements with descriptive notes

The GWP will:

• Provide input / comments related to the design concept

The TPL will:

• Provide input / comments related to the design concept

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

• A graphic depiction of the proposed concept in hardcopy / plotted format and a .pdf file that can be printed and/or made available on-line.

Task 5: Public Presentation / Public Input

The Consultant shall make refinements to the concept plan based on comments received from the GWP and TPL and shall prepare an updated concept plan for public review.

The Consultant shall facilitate a public meeting to be held in Safford to present and receive feedback related to the Conceptual Design. Prior to the meeting, the Consultant shall provide project information and graphics that can be used and/or distributed by the GWP, the City, or others to inform the public of the meeting and the proposed linear park improvements.

The Consultant shall also coordinate the public meeting which will be conducted using an open-house format with a brief presentation to attendees.

The Consultant will:

- Prepare exhibits (or PowerPoint presentation) for the public meeting
- Prepare informational handouts and comment sheets for the public meeting
- Prepare a summary of input received from meeting attendees

The GWP will:

- Coordinate with the City and/or County and secure a meeting room for the public meeting
- Coordinate with the City and/or County regarding advertising and legal public notice of the meeting

<u>The TPL will</u>:

• Participate in the public meeting, if feasible

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

- Hardcopy exhibits and/or a PowerPoint presentation
- Informational handouts and comments sheets for the public meeting
- A summary of input received from the public meeting attendees

Task 6: Pre-Final Master Plan Report

Using input received from the GWP, TPL, other stakeholders, and the public - the Consultant shall prepare a brief summary Master Plan report. The report shall include both graphics and a narrative description of the proposed improvements. The report shall be provided in draft form to the GWP and TPL for review and comment and will be revised to reflect input received.

The Consultant will:

• Prepare Pre-Final Master Plan report

The GWP will:

- Coordinate distribution of the Pre-Final Master Plan Report to appropriate stakeholders
- Review and provide written comments related to the Pre-Final Master Plan report

The TPL will:

• Review and provide written comments related to the Pre-Final Master Plan report

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

• Pre-Final Master Plan in .pdf file format

Task 7: Public Presentation to Elected Officials for review and adoption

The Consultant shall present the Master Plan report to the City of Safford City Council. The presentation will include a brief PowerPoint presentation that describes the planning process and the elements of the proposed master plan.

The Consultant will:

- Prepare a PowerPoint presentation of the proposed Master Plan
- Make a presentation to the Mayor and Council or assist the GWP with the presentation

The GWP will:

- Coordinate the scheduling of the presentation with City staff
- Assist with the presentation as-needed

<u>The TPL will</u>:

• Participate in the presentation as appropriate

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

• PowerPoint presentation of the proposed Master Plan in .ppt and .pdf file format

Task 8: Master Plan Finalization

The Consultant shall make revisions to the pre-final plan as directed by the City Council and as coordinated with the GWP and the TPL and shall prepare the final Master Plan report.

The Consultant will:

• Prepare the Final Master Plan Report

The GWP will:

• Coordinate distribution of the master plan to stakeholders

<u>The TPL will</u>:

• Coordinate the printing of hardcopies of the report, if needed

Deliverables to be Provided by the Consultant:

• Final Master Plan Report in .pdf file format

Information and services to be provided by the Gila Watershed Partnership

As noted above, the GWP shall provide the following information and services.

- Identify and invite stakeholders to the project workshops and meeting
- Arrange for meeting rooms for stakeholder and public meetings
- Coordinate the advertising and posting of notices for all project meetings
- Conduct or coordinate surveys of the vegetative communities within the project area

- Provide a map of the vegetative communities with supporting narrative descriptions
- Coordinate requests for data files from the City of Safford, Graham County, and/or others
- Provide input / comments related to the Conceptual Design
- Coordinate distribution of the Pre-Final Master Plan Report to appropriate stakeholders
- Review and provide written comments related to the Pre-Final Master Plan Report
- Coordinate distribution of the Final Master Plan to stakeholders

Information and Services to be provided by the Trust for Public Land:

The Trust for Public Land shall provide the following information and services.

- Participate in the workshops and meeting in person or by teleconference
- Provide input related to TPL's experience on similar projects
- Provide data files for the subject area as may have been collected by TPL
- Provide input / comments related to the design concept

Information and Services to be provided by the City of Safford and/or Graham County:

The City of Safford and/or Graham County shall provide the following information and services.

- Assistance to the GWP related to general notification of planned public meetings

Exclusions:

Specifically excluded from the scope of this project are:

- Hydrology studies and/or mapping of existing and future flood plains.
- Detailed project engineering and the preparation of construction documents for the master planned improvements.
- Other services not specifically identified herein.

Schedule:

All work shall be completed in accordance with a schedule prepared jointly by the Consultant and the Trust for Public Land.
