What is PayNearMe?

PayNearMe makes it easy and convenient for you to make a payment with cash at thousands of trusted payment locations nationwide, including participating CVS Pharmacy, 7-Eleven, Family Dollar, Casey's General Stores, and ACE Cash Express locations.

How can I make a PayNearMe payment?

Making a cash payment is easy! Follow these three steps:

- 1 Locate the barcode on your notice or get your code by visiting www.azcourtpay.com.
- 2 Show your barcode at any participating store and ask the cashier to make a cash payment. A \$2.99 fee applies. Before you go, know your balance due and how much you want to pay. The cashier will not have access to this information.
- 3 Keep your receipt. The court is notified automatically, and payment posts within 15 minutes.

How can I get my barcode?

Your barcode is found on your court notice or by visiting www.azcourtpay.com, and it can be taken directly to a participating retail store. You may re-use the same barcode each month.

Where can I make a payment?

Find a participating retailer nearest to you by visiting paynearme.com/map.

Who can I contact for help or questions about my account?

For questions about your case balance, call the Administrative Office of the Courts at (800) 720-7743.

When will the court be notified of my payment?

The court will be notified automatically, and payment will be applied within 15 minutes.

Is there a fee to make a cash payment?

A \$2.99 fee per payment applies for payment amounts up to \$1,000.
